white polo, privacy shorts (dark, solid color), white ankle socks or navy knee-high socks/tights.

Winter clothing

The uniform sweater and a solid colored, blue or black jacket (no hoodies or logos) may be worn over the uniform during the cold winter months. St. John Bosco jackets may be purchased in the office. *see handbook for more details

Girls Uniform Specifications

Girls may choose the unisex style or the polo made specifically for girls (smaller sleeve and fitted at the waist.)

Girls' skirts must be worn so that the length comes to the middle of the knee; if the entire kneecap shows, the skirt is too short.

Boys and Girls Dress Uniform Specifications

On dress days: The white button-up shirts for dress days can be long sleeve, mid-length, or short sleeve. A long sleeve sweater or shoulder width vest will be worn over the dress shirt at all times. Boys need to wear a solid navy standard necktie and girls wear a cross tie.

Shoes

The uniform shoes are a style rather than a specific shoe. All students in grades PreK –12th grade must wear proper shoes with their uniforms during each school day. All shoes must meet the following conditions:

- 1- They must be ALL black including the soles and laces.
- 2- Grades 9-12: Must wear a **dress shoe** made of leather or vinyl material that can be polished (no canvas-like materials), and be all black with no branding/distracting logos. Must be a closed-toe shoe with a back. No boots (such as Georgia boots), no plastic material shoes (such as crocs), and no slippers (such as Tom's & Hey Dude's). Girls may wear a heel if it does not exceed 2" in height.
- 3- Grades PreK-8: All-black flat dress shoes or tennis shoes. If there is branding, it must also be all-black. Must be a closed-toe shoe with a back. The shoe must be either laced, buckled, or Velcro. No boots (such as Georgia boots), no plastic material shoes (such as crocs), and no slippers (such as Tom's or Hey Dude's).
- 4- Winter shoes: snow or rain boots may be worn as needed for outdoor recess or travel to and from school. Uniform shoes are required inside the building.
- 5- P.E.- Indoor only, non-marking shoes required for all 2-12th grade students in any color to be left in the Angelus Center.

PE

Students in grades 5th -12th will need PE uniforms.

Only High school students taking PE as an elective need a PE uniform.

Both girls and boys will wear:

Navy blue shorts (no logos), no tight fitting or spandex, length past the fingers.

Navy blue sweatpants (no logos) may be worn in cooler weather.

Grey St. John Bosco t-shirt must be purchased from the school office, cost is \$10.

Athletic socks and athletic shoes, any color, but must have non-marking soles and be in new condition for use in the Angelus Center.

Thursday Dress Down

Grades 9-12 will dress down on Thursday after lunch for the school wide clean up and electives classes.

Dress down attire for boys and girls is: boot cut jeans and a St. John Bosco shirt. No exceptions.
